

## A WINTER WALK IN THE BLUNTAUTAL

Nestled between the sheer rock faces of the Göll massif to the north and the Hagengebirge range to the south, the Bluntautal nature reserve is one of Salzburg's most beautiful valleys. In winter, you can explore the stunning panorama on cross-country skis or on foot during a peaceful winter walk.

- The pristine Torrenerbach stream

## SLEIGH RIDES IN BLUNTAUTAL

The route for the sleigh ride passes by the two Bluntautal Lakes. From here, looking towards the mouth of the valley, you have a wonderful view of the surrounding mountains. Your journey continues to the Bärenhütte, and if there isn't too much snow and avalanche conditions permit, you can walk from there to the Torrener Waterfall. At the end of the valley, you will also find the Bärenhöhle, aptly named since bears did indeed once inhabit Bluntautal.

## WINTER HIKE AROUND THE RABENSTEIN

We begin in the town center, following Trönergasse to Egelsee, passing the Gustav Klimt Fountain. Here, 125 years ago, Gustav Klimt painted "A Morning by the Pond," and now a fountain commemorates this famous summer guest. Heading towards the Aqua Salza, we follow the signs along a picturesque forest path to St. Anton. The trail rises steeply in places, with an ascent of around 80 meters. At the top, we cross through the outdoor seating area of the St. Anton snack station, which is open on nice summer days.

From here, the path leads downhill to the Mitterbach, which we follow downstream, keeping Rabenstein on our left. Along the way, we pass the Schubert-Platzl. In 1827, Franz Schubert paused in Golling while traveling from Vienna to Bad Gastein and strolled around Rabenstein. Continuing past an old mill on the left, we make our way back to Golling via the tennis courts and middle school.

### Around the Rabenstein

Distance: 4 km

Elevation gain: 80 m

Duration: approx. 2 hours



# A SKI PARADISE

*IDYLIC WINTRY GOLLING OFFERS A WEALTH OF OPPORTUNITIES FOR SKIERS.*

Golling is the ideal base for your ski vacation. Centrally located near the Tauern Autobahn and at the start of the Lammertal valley, your skiing enjoyment is only a few minutes away – sun skiing at its finest in nearby ski resorts. Perfectly groomed slopes and rustic mountain huts await skiers. The free ski bus provides easy access to the Dachstein West ski areas, and the Ski amadé region is only about a 30-minute drive from Golling.

## DACHSTEIN WEST

The Dachstein West ski area extends across Russbach, Gosau, and Annaberg, amid the stunning peaks of the Dachstein, renowned for far more than skiing alone. Numerous “fun pistes” and a large freestyle snowpark offer excitement and thrills. Located **just 25 km from Golling**, Dachstein West is accessible by a **free daily ski shuttle** from Golling, then ski on a hill once used by World Cup champion Marcel Hirscher for training. The region features 65 modern cableways and ski lifts, boarder parks, freeride zones for individualists, four kids’ clubs with top-notch childcare, affordable family passes, and more. Ski rentals are generally available at the valley station; further details are available at the Golling Tourist Office.



## SKI AMADÉ

With 270 ski lifts and gondolas, Ski amadé is one of Europe’s biggest winter lift alliances. It encompasses 25 different resorts located throughout Salzburg and Styria. **Roughly 30 km from Golling**, the Salzburger Sportwelt lies at the heart of Ski amadé, providing excellent conditions for unparalleled ski enjoyment. State-of-the-art cableways, reliable snow conditions, well-maintained pistes, and diverse runs are hallmarks of all the Salzburger Sportwelt ski resorts. Ski rentals are also usually located near the valley stations; more information is available at the Golling Tourist Office.



## CULINARY TIPS IN FLACHAU


Whether you are skiing or après-skiing, the **Lisa Alm** is a must-visit, where the location, music, and true culinary artistry blend into something extraordinary. The numerous dishes and fine wines impress with top quality, creating a memorable experience. Their entertainment program is also one-of-a-kind: during the day, chill lounge music plays in the background, while at night, house and EDM rhythms set the scene.

In the center of Flachau stands an old cow barn transformed into a modern dining spot with Austrian cuisine infused with Asian influences: **Hoagascht** Restaurant & Bar. The chef himself and his experienced team always manage to surprise guests with special delicacies. Reservations are a must!

# SMALL, BUT OH MY!

SMALL SKI AREAS AROUND GOLLING HAVE SO MUCH TO OFFER.



## MOOSEGG SKI AREA | GASTHOF BAICHRAIN

Just a 15-minute drive from Golling, the Moosegg ski area is a winter idyll on a sunny plateau. Here, you will find peaceful surroundings without traffic or mass tourism.

Ideal for children and beginners, it features a **magic carpet lift** and small yet charming slopes right outside the Bio-Berggasthof Bachrain. Behind the inn, you have access to the **Kerterer cross-country** ski trail, where you can glide for 4 km using either classic or skating technique through untouched nature.

There, you will also discover a 2 km **natural toboggan run** – a huge family favorite! Toboggans are available at the inn to borrow. And on the maintained winter trails around Bio-Berggasthof Bachrain, you can enjoy **snowshoeing or hiking** amid picturesque winter landscapes and crystal-clear mountain air. Snowshoes are also available for rent, and guided snowshoe hikes are offered in the area.

**Our special tip:** After a day on the trail, unwind on the sunny panoramic terrace at Bio-Berggasthof, enjoying magnificent views of the Salzburg mountains, along with homemade treats, coffee, and cake, or a refreshing drink.



## POSTALM SKI AREA

Nestled in the mountains of the Salzkammergut, this unique recreation area at 1,100 meters above sea level extends across one of Europe's largest expanses of alpine pastures. A gentle, harmonious winter paradise in harmony with nature, far removed from the hustle and bustle of busier ski resorts.

The reliable snowfall at altitudes between 1,100 and 1,900 meters ensures **excellent natural-snow slopes**: three T-bar tows, a button lift, a chairlift, and a covered magic carpet. These serve several blue-rated runs, perfect for beginners and anyone who enjoys easygoing skiing. Two red runs are available for more advanced skiers, along with one black hill for experts and adventurous thrill-seekers.

The Postalm also features some of the most beautiful **cross-country ski trails** in the Salzkammergut. With three high-altitude trails, a beginner's loop, and even a dog-friendly trail, you are greeted by a total of 25 km of trails groomed for both classic and skating techniques. You will also discover four ski **touring routes**, suitable for both newcomers and seasoned skiers.

**Our special tip:** Try the **natural toboggan run and tube riding at the Postalm!** A unique new highlight awaits: the button lift will pull you and your sled up the hill! On weekends, the entire run is lit up for nighttime sledding. Sleds can be borrowed at the Stroblerrhütte.



## WERFENWENG SKI AREA

Only 30 minutes from Golling, Werfenweng's **family-friendly ski area** is easily accessible, allowing you to jump right into the fun. Small yet impressive, Werfenweng offers not only reliable snow conditions but also opportunities for ski touring, sledding, cross-country skiing, and scenic winter walks.

With 29 variety-packed kilometers of pistes, modern lifts, and breathtaking views, the Werfenweng ski area has something to excite families, beginners, and experienced skiers alike.

You will find a well-maintained **network of trails** that appeals to both "skaters" and classic cross-country skiers, extending from the valley to the picturesque end of the Wengerau, or to the paragliding landing area in Zaglau.

A **sledding adventure** is always a great idea! In Werfenweng, you have your pick of several runs. Your outing will become even more memorable when paired with a visit to a cozy mountain inn.

Werfenweng is also a year-round hotspot for **paragliders**. Bischling mountain, along with the dramatic limestone crags of the Tennengebirge, offers an ideal launch point for an unforgettable flight, with practically always ideal wind conditions at the 1,840-meter-high starting point.



## DÜRRNBERG SKI AREA

Just 20 minutes from Golling, the Dürrnberg ski area is a **hidden gem perfect for families** who want a peaceful, uncrowded skiing experience. Small yet exciting, it is Salzburg's first all-inclusive ski area, where you can enjoy four hours of skiing happiness and then refuel at the Zinkenstüberl café at unbeatable prices!



## KARKOGEL SKI AREA IN ABTENAU

The Karkogel ski area in Abtenau is about 20 minutes from Golling. This resort is particularly well suited for a family ski day with young children, as well as for beginning skiers and snowboarders. It is also ideal for deep-snow enthusiasts and ski tourers, who will find plenty to enjoy here.

**Our special tip:** Be sure to stop by by one of the cozy mountain huts during your ski holiday – an experience not to be missed!

## WINTER HIKING & SNOWSHOEING

Many trails in and around Golling invite you to enjoy an enchanting winter walk. Just set out – no special equipment or extensive preparation needed. Breathe in the crisp winter air, leave the everyday behind, and savor the peace and quiet. Kilometers of trails and snowy landscapes are just waiting to be explored. Combine your hike with a fun sledding adventure and warm up afterwards in one of the cozy huts dotted throughout the Tennengau.

Our tip: **Try winter hiking in Werfenweng.** In the colder months, the diverse landscape is perfect for relaxed walks. Bundle up and take advantage of the extensive winter trail network or go „off-road“ with snowshoes to discover a pristine winter paradise.

### Shorter Walks and Hikes

- Around the Rabenstein
- Along the Salzach River toward Kuchl
- Around Seewaldsee
- Through Bluntautal

## CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

In snowy winters, Golling offers a unique cross-country trail winding through the enchanting Bluntau Valley along the Bluntau Arche. Afterwards, a stop at Gasthof Göllhof, conveniently located by the parking area, is highly recommended. The surrounding area provides even more options, with Tennengau boasting over 30 cross-country trails, ranging from easy to challenging. In total, there are 10 cross-country areas, with Annaberg and Abtenau also offering two illuminated trails for night skiing. Plus, with the TennengauPLUS Card, you can travel for free on public transit.

Our tip: Just behind the Bio-Berggasthof Bachrain, you will find the **Kerterer Trail**. Here, on the sunny Moosegg plateau, you can glide through 4 km of virgin nature using either classic or skating technique.

## SKI TOURING

The region between the Salzkammergut and Tennengau is a dream for ski tourers, with mountains soaring up to 1,800 meters above sea level, seemingly created just for ski touring. There is something here for everyone! Important: Always check the current avalanche threat conditions before every tour.

## ICE SKATING

Ice skating in SalzburgerLand is a winter joy that comes in endless forms, from indoor rinks to outdoor spots and even lakes.

The 450 m<sup>2</sup> skating rink on the Bürgerausee in Kuchl has plenty of space for skaters of all abilities – from beginners making their first attempts to advanced skaters gliding across the ice. Perfectly fitting skates can be rented on location.

In any weather, you can also skate in Salzburg city, either at the Mozarteis rink or the Ice Arena, where 3,600 m<sup>2</sup> of covered ice promises fun for the whole family. Ice Arena Salzburg isn't just a popular spot for recreational skaters, it is also the home venue of the EC Red Bull Salzburg ice hockey team.

## SLEDDING

Sledding is a fantastic activity for the whole family! Winter sledding combines several wonderful elements: time spent in nature and fresh air, fun for young and old alike, and an experience that brings everyone together.

### Natural Sledding Hills:

- **Bachrain:** This 1.8 km run is not too steep, making it perfect for families with children. Sleds are available for rent right there at the inn, and, of course, a cozy stop for refreshments is a must!
- **Karkogel in Abtenau:** Take a relaxing gondola ride up the Karkogel in Abtenau. The 3.2 km natural sled run winds down the hill, allowing each person to set their own pace. Evening sledding is especially popular: every Tuesday, Friday, and Saturday, you can ride the gondola up the mountain until 8:30 pm, and the trail stays lit until 10:30 pm.
- **Postalm:** Located on a sunny plateau between Abtenau and Strobl, this approximately 1 km run follows a scenic route with the Stroblhütte along the way – perfect for a refreshment stop! Every Friday in February, the hut offers ribs for dinner followed by a fun nighttime sledding experience. Sleds are available at the Stroblhütte to borrow.

- **Trattberg in St. Koloman:** Starting just after the toll gate, your sledding adventure first involves a scenic 1 to 1.5-hour hike up a gently climbing forest road leading to the Enzianhütte. You are treated to beautiful views along the way, culminating in a stunning panorama at the top. Enjoy a warming refreshment break at the hut before embarking on a thrilling ride all the way back down to the bottom.

### Piste-Side Sled Runs accessible by Lift:

- 11 sled runs in the Ski Amadé area
- Schladming sled run

**Our tip:** Try sledding at the Sattelbauer in Flachau. You can either hike up the mountain or hitch a ride with one of the Flachau sledding taxis. Yet another great option is sledding in Altenmarkt near the Bifeishütte – great fun for all ages on the snowy, floodlit sled run in Altenmarkt Zauchensee.

In Golling, the wait for Christmas Eve is made shorter thanks to the aromas of Christmas cookies, bustling Christmas markets, and Christkind visiting the castle. Krampus parades, Advent readings, visits from Saint Nicholas, and Perchten performances fill the events calendar!

A winter holiday in Tennengau is often the most cherished time of the year for both guests and locals alike. As the year draws to a close, a very special season begins in SalzburgerLand: Advent.

## PEACEFUL HOLIDAY MOMENTS

The idyllic Christmas markets in Golling and surrounding areas kick off Advent season in SalzburgerLand. Lovingly crafted handmade items and treats like Kletzenbrot, roasted chestnuts, mulled wine, winter teas, knitted, felted and crocheted items, and wood-turned pieces are all offered for sale at these markets, and accompanied by traditional folk customs of the Tennengau region.

## TRADITIONAL EVENTS

From the first Advent weekend through December 6, Krampus parades take place throughout our holiday region. The Golling Krampuslauf on Market Street, featuring eerie-yet-beautiful Krampuses as well as Saint Nicholas, is a highlight of Golling's Advent festivities.

## FARMERS' ADVENT MARKET

This romantic market run by farmer's wives from in and around Golling is set up along the banks of the Egelsee. Local specialties and delectable treats, such as bread, bacon, a variety of dumplings, cookies, and Christmas decorations, are offered – but be sure to come early, as this market is far from a well-



kept secret! Here, you will find many tasty morsels that aren't available the rest of the year. Stalls serving mulled wine, punch, roasted chestnuts, and Bauernkrapfen are just a few of the diverse culinary offerings. Wind musicians add a festive musical flavor of their own, conjuring up a true Christmas spirit.

## GOLLING CASTLE ADVENT

Golling Castle Advent offers a magical experience within the historic castle setting. In the atmospheric courtyard, a gourmet



market invites visitors to linger, with regional partners showcasing their high-quality products, accompanied by music and a traditional nativity play. Inside the castle hall, artisans from Tennengau display their talents at an arts & crafts market. Unique, lovingly handcrafted pieces are available for those in search of something special. Children are in good hands, too, with a varied program that includes a living Christkind in the castle chapel, a puppet theater, and a crafts workshop to keep them thoroughly entertained. Horse-drawn carriage rides and walks with alpacas further add to the charm of the event.

## SILENT NIGHT MUSEUM IN HALLEIN

The world's most famous Christmas carol was born here, yet few know that its composer, Franz Xaver Gruber, lived in Hallein, across from the parish church. Today, this is the site of the Silent Night Museum, where the origins and spread of the beloved carol are documented. On display are the original manuscript and the guitar which Joseph Mohr used when he first performed the song on Christmas Eve in 1818.

## ADVENT IN SALZBURG

Christmas markets, Advent concerts, and traditional events enchant visitors to the city of Mozart. As Advent begins in late November, Salzburg's charm becomes even more magical. The scents of roasted chestnuts, spiced mulled wine, and tasty cookies fill the streets of the historic district. A visit to the Salzburg Christkindlmarkt, located on Cathedral Square and the Residenzplatz, is simply a must; it is one of the most beautiful Christmas markets in the world. Families, in particular, really love the enchanting Advent Magic market at Hellbrunn, while the more peaceful Advent Market on Mirabellplatz, near Mirabell Gardens, and the Advent Market up at Hohensalzburg Fortress are also well worth a visit.





# ART & CULTURE AT GOLLING CASTLE

A DIVERSE RANGE OF ART & CULTURE EVENTS APPEALING TO ALL TASTES



Movements spark change. The first solo concerts by members of the Vienna Philharmonic took place at Döllerer in 1998/99. In 2000, the idea emerged to transform these concerts into a series of five performances at Golling Castle. These chamber music concerts, featuring musicians like Clemens Hellsberg, Peter Pecha, and Martin Kubik, originally hosted 40 guests per performance. The beautiful music, combined with the atmospheric setting of the castle courtyard and the exquisite cuisine from Döllerer, captivated audiences. Demand grew for more. The "Small Festival" expanded, adding more variety and attracting an increasing number of festival-goers. Each year, renowned musicians, actors, and singers touch the hearts of audiences with their performances. Today, up to 300 people attend each show, and the number of events has grown to 20 performances each festival season. The culinary offerings from

Döllerer's Genusswelten continue to impress countless festival guests, transforming the "Small Festival" into a veritable "Art & Culinary Festival."

### A VARIED PROGRAM

In addition to the Golling Festival, Golling Castle hosts a full calendar of events throughout the year, including traditional folk music evenings, the legendary "Sternenkindo," and concerts such as a rockin' night with Rusty. With its prime location in SalzburgerLand, Golling Castle has become a unique cultural and event hub in Tennengau.

The "Small Festival" is all grown up. The 20th anniversary of the Art & Culinary Festival at Golling Castle was celebrated with 17 outstanding performances.



# FINE DINING WITH A LONG TRADITION

*GOLLING'S COLORFUL CULINARY SCENE LEAVES (ALMOST)

The market town of Golling boasts one of the most beautiful enclosed squares in the Salzburg region. Protected by the medieval castle perched on a rocky outcrop, a double row of houses has developed over centuries along this important north-south route, giving the town its unique character.

Travelers, artists, merchants, carriages, soldiers, and others passing through sought food and lodging here, a day's journey from Salzburg. Before motorized transport, pedestrians, riders,

and carriages with horses and goods all needed safe places to rest up, with many inns in town offering accommodations. The mighty, arched gateways allowed carriages to enter the courtyards.

Not long after 1800, an early form of tourism developed in Golling. Romantic nature enthusiasts came to experience the unspoiled scenery, while traveling artists came to paint the peaceful town, the waterfall, and the Salzach gorge. By the 19th

century, Golling had earned a prominent place in European travel literature, and many views of the town were widely published.

In 1875, Golling was connected to the Empress Elisabeth Railway Network, which led to a major boost in tourism. Golling became a popular summer retreat for guests from Vienna who would come with their families and servants to stay for several weeks. Local hoteliers and innkeepers improved their food and drink offerings and upgraded guest rooms, while cultural events provided entertainment. This tradition continues today, ensuring guests an exceptionally pleasant stay.

## KAISERSCHMARRN WITH PLUM COMPOTE

### INGREDIENTS:

#### Schmarrn:

250 ml milk  
140 g flour  
4 eggs  
20 g sugar  
1 tbsp raisins  
1 tbsp butter  
60 g granulated sugar  
1 tbsp butter  
80 g coarsely chopped walnuts

#### Plum Compote:

500 g ripe plums  
80 g granulated sugar  
150 ml red wine  
100 ml port wine  
1 cinnamon stick  
1 star anise  
½ vanilla pod  
250 ml plum juice  
A bit of cornstarch

### PREPARATION:

#### Schmarrn:

Combine the milk, flour, and egg yolks. Beat the egg whites with the granulated sugar until stiff and fold into the batter. Melt butter in a pan, pour in the batter about 3 cm thick, and sprinkle with a few raisins. Bake in a preheated oven at 180°C for about 15 minutes. Flip the Schmarrn and tear it into evenly sized pieces with two forks. Caramelize the granulated sugar in a pan, add the Schmarrn pieces and butter, and mix until a thin layer of caramel coats the pieces.

#### Plum Compote:

Caramelize the sugar, deglaze with red wine and port, and allow to reduce. Add the halved plums and spices, then the plum juice. Cover and simmer for about 8 minutes, thickening slightly if needed.





We parked at the toll gate (Parking there in winter costs €5.00). From there, we followed the maintained Trattberg road out to the Enzianhütte and continued northeast, up two mountainsides leading to the summit cross, all the

while surrounded by stunning mountain views. Heimo hadn’t exaggerated – the scenery was breathtaking indeed. We glided through the powder snow back down to the Enzianhütte, where we rewarded ourselves with a hearty “Brettlause” snack.

That evening, we wound down our adventurous day at the Taj Palace Indian restaurant, right in the center of romantically lit-up Golling. It was a welcome change of pace from the cheesecake and Brettlause. Amazing how diverse this little gem of a community on the River Salzach truly is!

## DAY 3: TOBOGGANING AND ALL-OUT RELAXATION

The impressive mountain panorama from the previous day had captivated us so much that we only wanted one thing: to get back up on those mountains. We were eager to feel the sun on our faces, even as the afternoon shadows were already beginning to spread across the valleys below; Able to gaze over the snow-covered peaks, savor the silence, and let ourselves become completely absorbed in the moments of utter peace and silence. We rented two toboggans from Sport Moser and made our way to Berggasthof Bachrain. The trail led us through forests blanketed in snow. Our efforts were rewarded with incredible views – the clear winter air and untouched nature allowed us to take deep, refreshing breaths.

At the top, the mountain inn welcomed us with one particular culinary highlight: homemade cheese dumplings (Kaspressknödel) and the world’s best Kaiserschmarrn, crispy yet fluffy. We sat in the warming sun, hearts full of joy, savoring life. But the best was yet to come – the thrilling ride downhill on our toboggans, an experience that left us with lasting memories.

In the evening, we rounded off this winter dream at Gasthof Döllerer. This traditional inn, known far beyond Salzburg, treated us to an extraordinary blend of regional classics and creative interpretations. Every bite was a journey for the palate. And then our holiday came to an end, after three days jam-packed with new experiences, with a leisurely evening stroll around Lake Egelsee. The perfect close to an unforgettable time, leaving us enriched and brimming over with wonderful impressions.



The tubing hill is open under the lights on Sundays and public holidays until 8:00 pm, and until 9:00 pm on Fridays and Saturdays.

If you need a break, treat yourself to some snacks at the cozy hut, watching the kids shuttle endlessly up and down the hillside. And even if the snow is a little lacking elsewhere, this particular facility can make its own snow whenever temperatures are right!
